

Enrollment

All Saints currently has 309 students from 202 families attending grades Pre-K through 8th grade. For the 2007-08 school year there is one Pre-K class, two classes each of Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 7th grade, and one class each of 5th grade, 6th grade and 8th grade.

Administration/Faculty

Anne Scalet is the principal for All Saints and Todd Shildt and Pat Meier are the Co-Assistant Principals. All Saints has 23 teachers and 2 aides on staff.

Accreditation and Standardized Testing

All Saints is accredited by the Oklahoma Conference of Catholic Schools Accreditation Association, which is recognized by the State Department of Education. All Saints consistently scores above the 90th percentile on the Iowa Tests of Basic Skills, which are administered in grades 2-8.

Academics and Special Activities

In addition to the standard academic subjects, All Saints offers many specialized subjects including art, computers, drama, music, religion, Spanish and speech. Students enjoy learning more about these subjects in the school's 28-station computer lab and information center, science lab, art room and music room. The school also offers many sports and other extracurricular activities. Students can participate in basketball, football, track and volleyball. They may also participate in activities such as the chess club, geography bee, MathCounts, scouts, speech contest and spelling bee.

Christian Service and Spiritual Growth

All grades participate in Christian service projects. Service is required in grades 6-8. Opportunities for spiritual growth include daily prayer and religion class, weekly Mass celebrated as a school, and the Adopt-a-Priest program.

Parent Involvement

All Saints encourages parent involvement and offers many opportunities to participate. Parents stay active with PTO, Care and Share Program, coaching, school advisory council, committees and fundraising.

Tuition Assistance

Tuition assistance is available through the school and through the Diocese of Tulsa.

Hours and Extended Day Programs

The school day begins at 8:40 A.M. Pre-K through 3rd grade are dismissed at 3:20 P.M. and grades 4-8 are dismissed at 3:30 P.M. A Before and After Care program is available.

Hot Lunch and Milk Program

All Saints offers a catered hot lunch program and a milk program.
